PDI Checklist for Tata Punch.ev - Draft version

- Before completing the PDI, only pay the pre-booking amount.
 Dealers may ask for more, citing month-end targets or providing alternative vehicles if the PDI fails. Do not fall for this.
- Ask the Sales Advisor (SA) to complete the PDI and confirm it before your visit. Request the chassis number of the vehicle for tracking purposes.
- 3. Inform SA to ensures the car is at least at 40% charge for your PDI.
- 4. Schedule the PDI during daytime and plan to spend at least one hour.
- 5. Take a photo for memory.
- 6. Carry USB Type-A and Type C cable, 12v charger (try tyre inflator)
- 7. Ask dealer to verify AC and DC charging works.

Check Paint Inspection and body panels Check

Verify no scratches on Jewel knob and infortainment screen

Check Cabin Light shaking issue

Check horn is working

Open and close 4 windows and check squeaky noise

Adjust left and right OVRM

Close OVRM**

Check both wireless Keys and manual key is workings

Check all door handles are working and not scratched

Check driver door unlocks with the request button

Check possibility of Tata Power DC charger

- Once the PDI is successfully completed, the payment/ loan release can be initiated.
- User manual can be collected for reference, it might need to be taken
- for stamping on the day of delivery.

 Collect the 3.3kw charger box and ask the dealer to initiate the installation procedure, so that it is ready by the time car is delivered.
